Minutes of the 9th (Ninth) Alumni Meet (General Body Meeting) of the Utkal Statistics Alumni Association (USAA) held on 11.02.2024 (Sunday).

The 9th (Ninth) Alumni Meet of the Utkal Statistics Alumni Association (USSA) was held under the Chairmanship of Sri Rabindra Kumar Mohanty, President of the Association, in the PG Department of Statistics, Utkal University, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar on 11.02.2024 (Sunday). Registration of participants started sharp at 09:30 am and each participant was given a set of reference materials i.e. (i) a copy of the programme for the day, (ii) a copy of the Annual Activity Report of USAA for the year 2022-23, and (iii) a pad, pen etc.

The meet was organised in 5 (five) sessions i.e. (i) Inaugural Session, (ii) Introduction of Members, (iii) Election to the Fifth Executive Committee of USAA, (iv) Interactive Session and (iv) Cultural Programme with a Lunch Break in the middle.

I. INAUGURAL SESSION: (10:30 am to 11:30 am):

At the outset, Ms Khushi Agrawal our Alumni Member of 2022 welcomed to the Dias Prof Minati Mishra, an Alumni of 1969 has her vast experience and expertise in Operations Research, Quantitative Analysis, Financial Analysis and occupied high positions in National and International spheres as Chief Guest of the day. She also welcomed the senior most Alumni Member present on the day Sri M Bhaskar Rao (1961) as the Guest of Honor. Then she welcomed our President Sri Rabindra Kumar Mohanty, the Working President Dr Priya Ranjan Dash, and the Secretary Sri Anadi Charan Das to the Dias and requested to them to please take their seats. Flower bouquets were presented to hon'ble dignitaries on the Dias by students of the Department after they had taken their seats.

Dr Priya Ranjan Dash gave a very brief welcome address about the dignitaries on the Dias as well as all the alumni members and requested the President and all other members to light the inaugural lamp. Accordingly, hon'ble President lighted the lamp amidst the Chief Guest as well as all other members present on the occasion. After lighting of lamp and the dignitaries occupied their seats, the Utkal University Theme Song was played in a pin drop silence atmosphere. After the University Theme Song, an opening song was also staged by a group of 1st and 2nd year students.

Prof Priya Ranjan Dash introduced the dignitaries on the Dias and welcomed them to the august occasion. Before formal business of the Meet, Prof Dash expressed in grief that it has come to the knowledge of USAA that one of our senior Alumni Member Dr Mukul Kumar Bal (1964) and the former Section Officer of the Department of Statistics Sri Radhashyama Choudhury have left for Heavenly Abode in between the Eighth and the Ninth Alumni Meet. At this, all the Members stood up and observed a token of condolence for the departed souls silently.

On the request of Dr P R Dash, Sri Rabindra Kumar Mohanty, President USAA initiated the business of the meeting and solicited valued contributions from among the alumni members so as to give new dimensions to the Alumni Body. He also expressed that our Alumni Meet to be meaningful, apart from meeting our old friends, we should share our experience, expertise and give constructive suggestions to carry on the activities of USAA in a meaningful manner which will help enriching the subject and our students will get the benefit.

(i) On the request of the President, Sri Anadi Charan Das, General Secretary, USAA read out the Annual Reports of the Association for the year ending 2022-23 for information of esteemed members. He gave a detailed account of various activities done by the USAA during last year, the present position and the steps to be taken ahead which was reflected in the Annual Activity Report 2022-23 that had been circulated among the members in the meeting. In giving the receipt and expenditure position of USAA for the years 2022-23, he stated that the opening balance at the beginning of the year was Rs.7,39,525.26 (cash: Rs.25,750.00, Bank: Rs.6,13,775.26 and FD: Rs.1,00,000.00). During the year, other receipts worth Rs.2,00,010.00 aggregated to a total receipt of Rs.9,39,535.26. Other receipts included member registration fees, contribution, donation, corpus fund and bank interest. As against the total receipt, the expenditure during the year was of the order of Rs.1,33,080.00 that included expenditures on Eighth Alumni Meet, distribution of prizes, and other office expenses. The closing balance at the end of these years was Rs.8,06,455.26 that includes Rs.38,360.00 (in cash), Rs.1,68,095.26 (in bank) and Rs.6,00,000.00 (fixed deposit). The accounts for the years 2022-23 have since been audited.

With this, he solicited considered opinion and valued suggestions of esteemed members for better functioning of USAA in future.

(ii) Distribution of Prize: On the request of Prof Priya Ranjan Dash, Sri Rabindra Kumar Mohanty, President USAA distributed cash prize as well as certificates of merit to students of the Department and rank holders in the Statistics Olympiad 2023. - (iv) The Chief Guest Dr Minati Mishra in her address highlighted that application of Statistics is very vast and not confined to sectors like agriculture, health, industry, fishery and etc. Its applicability is not only vast but enormous. It has its application in all sectors and subsectors of development as also in decision making, administration, law and order, defence, national and international business and policy making. We need not confine ourselves to Government jobs only. Our class room teaching is not sufficient for wide range of exposure and expertise. For better future, we need further more training and exposure at national and international levels. Once we enhance our ability and capability, better placement will not be a dream. In giving her own example, after doing her Master's Degree from this institution, she served here as a faculty for some time. Then she did her work in the field of Quantitative Analysis and Operations Research and did her Ph D Degree from the Stern School of Business, New York. After seven years of academia, she entered into the Business World for three years at American Telephone and Telegraph (AT&T) as a member of their Business Research Group followed by two years with American Express in charge of Credit Card Risk Management. She then joined the International Finance Corporation (IFC). She was the first woman to have Chaired the Annual Webster's MTN Conference on Achievement demonstrating her recognition within the dealing community. Further, she stated that she was one of the top 50 Women in Finance in the World. In addition, she had occupied various national and international positions in her life time. Presently she is the Co-founder and Treasurer in Panchee Foundation since 2019. In saying so, she urged upon the students to do their best in order see a better horizon in their life. With this, she wished better future for the student alumni and the Alumni Meet a Grand Success.
- (v) Before giving his inaugural address, Sri Rabindra Kumar Mohanty, President, USAA extended a hearty and warm welcome to the dignitaries on the Dais as well as to the august audience of Alumni Members. He recollected his past days in the Department and compared the facilities

and environmental opportunities available in the past and present. There has been a tragic change and the present day atmosphere is more conducive for better exposure and better learning. Employment opportunities are not confined to public sector today as in the past. If there is mind, sky is the limit for educational achievement and skill development as also for employment opportunities. He advised the students never to dream only but to do hard labour to make their dreams a reality. He expressed that as a result of USAA something has been done for the cause of Statistics and the Statisticians. But something more could be done in that regard. He appreciated the views expressed by the Chief Guest. He cited the example of Henry Ford, the Head of the Ford Company, who was always saying vision without execution is just only hallucination. Thomas Jefferson, the third President of USA who was always saying "Knowledge is Power", "Knowledge is Happiness" and "Knowledge is Safety". We should learn from them. Lot many things can be done further more if we join our hands and do our best. With these words, the President urged for meaningful deliberations in the meeting.

- (vi) Sri M Bhaskar Rao (1961), the senior most Alumni Member present on the occasion and the Guest of Honour of the day in addressing the dignitaries on the Dais as well as the audience, started his speech with a Saraswati Bandana, "Yakundendu tusar hara dhabala" and expressed that this Department is as good as "Maa Saraswati". The term of office of an Executive Committee is normally 2 (two) years. The Fourth Executive Committee was formed in the Seventh General Body Meeting on 19.12.2021 (Sunday).
